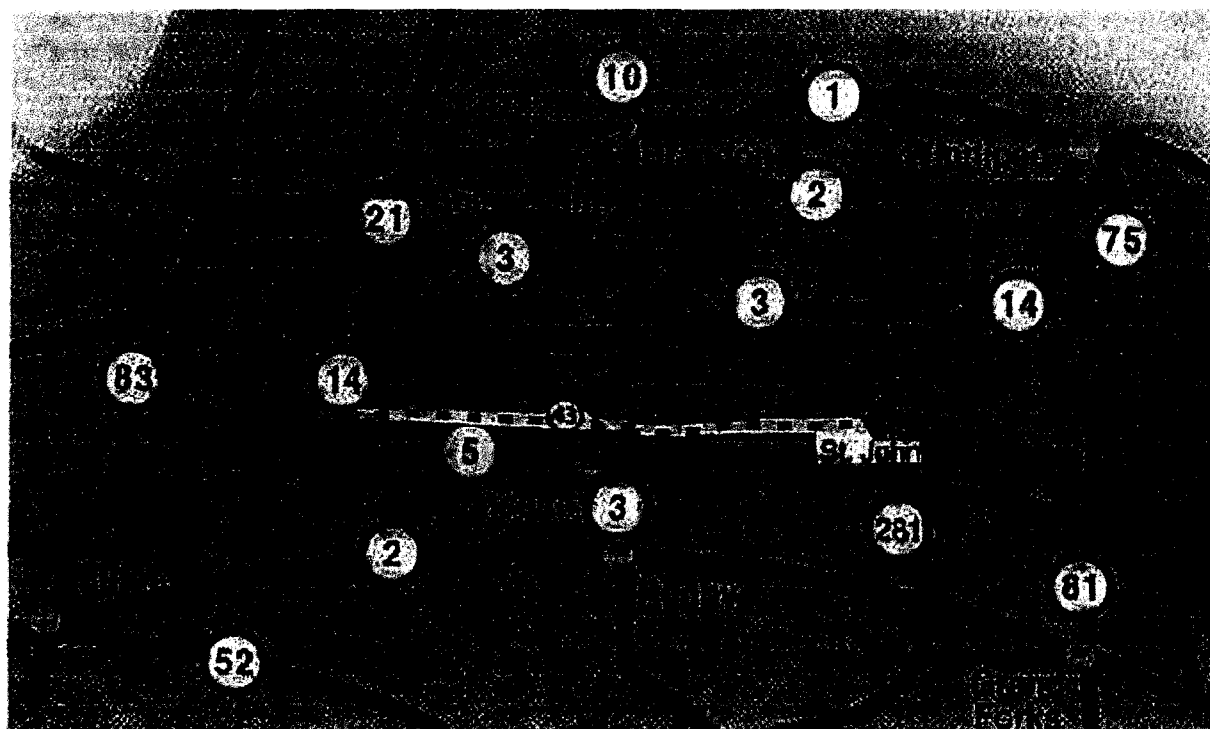

*Total from Grand Forks - 256 miles*

### **From Winnipeg, Manitoba:**

West on Trans Canada Hwy 1 to Brandon (133 miles, 214 km)  
South on Hwy 10 to Peace Garden (70 miles, 113 km)  
*Total from Winnipeg - 203 miles (327 km)*

### **From Regina, Saskatchewan:**

East on Trans Canada Hwy 1 to Brandon (224 miles, 361 km)  
South on Hwy 10 to Peace Garden (70 miles, 113 km)  
*Total from Regina - 314 miles (474 km)*
