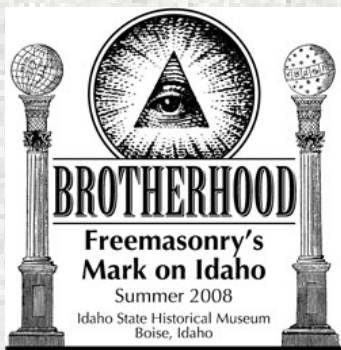
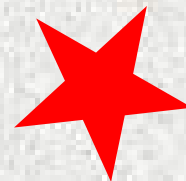
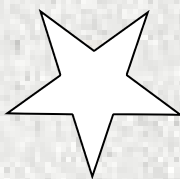
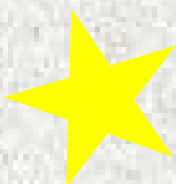


Star Points of Interest
