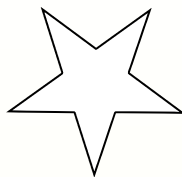
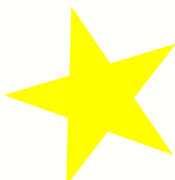

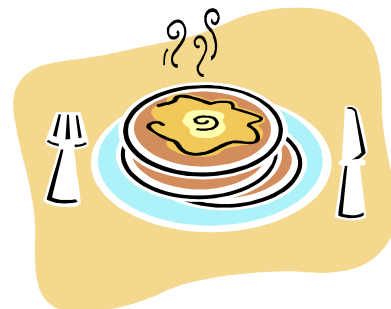

New Chapter in Mexico

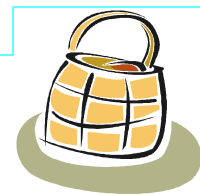
