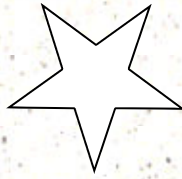

Now, of course, if you can't help on First Thursdays, there's still a need. Please call Anne

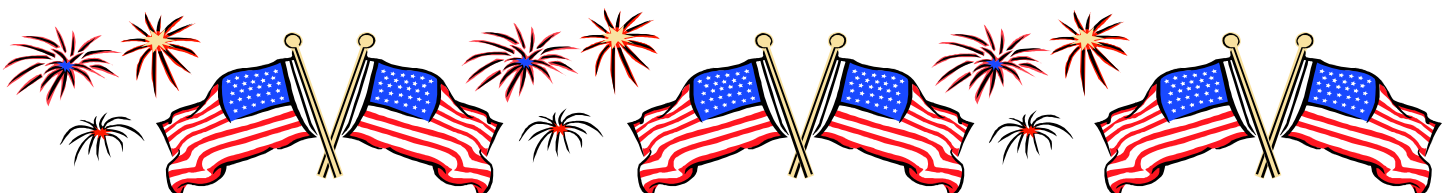
