- Written Test on Ritual knowledge

Rules for Ritual Competition

- You will be judged using the **2009** Ritual and the **2011** Idaho Code & Digest.
- All Ritual Work Competitors will be judged on accuracy and expression. Star Point Teams will also be judged on Secret Work and floor work. A volunteer Conductress and Candidate will be present for all competitors.
- Bring your own ritual if you want your mistakes marked.
- Dress Code: Ladies may wear street or floor length dresses/skirts. Ladies may **not** wear slacks. Men may wear slacks and a casual shirt. **No tank tops, shorts or jeans are allowed.**
