- c. Sponsored by an Eastern Star Chapter in the State of Idaho.

Students must submit their completed application to your Chapter by April 1, 2026. Chapter Secretaries, please forward these completed forms with Chapter seal affixed to me by April 15, 2026.

GRAND CHAPTER OF IDAHO ORDER OF THE EASTERN STAR

Scholarship Application

Eligibility

In order to be considered for a Grand Chapter of Idaho, Order of the Eastern Star academic scholarship you must be:

- A member of the Order of the Eastern Star, **or** related to a member of the Order of the Eastern Star, who is either your parent or grandparent. They may be living or deceased, and must be a member in good standing or a member who was in good standing at the time of their death.
- Currently enrolled in a college, university, or an accredited professional/technical school. Preference will be given to students attending Idaho educational institutions.
- If a college or university, you must be a **full time** Junior, Senior, or Graduate student.
- Sponsored by an Eastern Star chapter in the State of Idaho

Instructions

- Complete this application
- Attach a copy of your most current college transcript – an unofficial transcript is acceptable
- Include two letters of reference – they may be from family & friends, employers, teachers & professors, but preference will be given to academic and professional references.
- Include a statement of your goals and ambitions

Deadline for Application

- Application must be received by the local Eastern Star Chapter by April 1
- Delivered from the local chapter to the Chairperson of Scholarship Committee by April 15

Additional Information

- Applications which are incomplete will not be considered
- Determination of scholarship awards will be made by the Scholarship Committee based on academic achievement; academic intensity (credit hour load, course difficulty); financial need; Masonic, extracurricular, and community involvement; honors and recognition; statement of goals and ambitions; personal, professional or academic references
- Awards will be announced at the Idaho Grand Chapter session in June
- Applicants will be informed following the session.
- Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the educational institution
